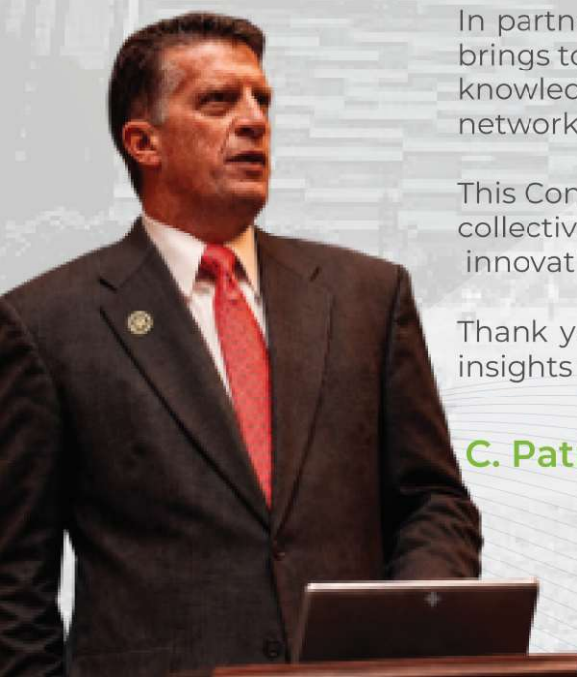

## TECHNICAL VISITS



### TV1: West Coast Expressway (WCE)

The West Coast Expressway (WCE) is a 233-km strategic highway corridor enhancing connectivity along the west coast of Peninsular, which runs from Banting, Selangor and ends at Taiping, Perak. Designed to complement existing north-south routes, the expressway improves traffic distribution and regional accessibility across Selangor and Perak. The project highlights advanced traffic management

systems, safety features and modern tolling infrastructure. Developed to support growing traffic demand while minimising environmental and community impact, WCE reflects Malaysia's continued advancement in sustainable highway planning, construction methodologies and operational efficiency within a highly developed urban corridor.



### TV2: East Coast Rail Link (ECRL) Project

The East Coast Rail Link (ECRL) is a transformative 665-km electrified railway connecting the East Coast states to the Klang Valley and Port Klang. Designed for both passenger and freight services, the project enhances multimodal logistics integration and strengthens national transport resilience. Traversing diverse topography, the alignment incorporates extensive tunnelling works, long-span viaducts,

advanced geotechnical solutions, and modern rail systems. With design speeds of up to 160 km/h, the ECRL represents a major step toward sustainable and efficient land transport. The project underscores strategic infrastructure development aimed at balancing regional growth while modernising Malaysia's rail network to international standards.



### TV3: Kuala Lumpur Command And Control Centre (KLCCC)

The Kuala Lumpur Command and Control Centre serves as the central hub for integrated traffic and urban operations management in Kuala Lumpur. Equipped with thousands of high-definition CCTV cameras, traffic sensors, and data integration platforms, the centre enables real-time monitoring and coordinated response across the city's road

network. Leveraging intelligent transport systems (ITS), data analytics, and inter-agency connectivity, KLCCC enhances congestion management, incident response, and public safety operations. As a key component of Kuala Lumpur's smart city framework, the centre exemplifies the application of digital technologies in optimising urban mobility and improving overall traffic network performance.



### TV4: East Klang Valley Expressway (EKVE)

The East Klang Valley Expressway (EKVE) is a 39-km expressway forming part of the Kuala Lumpur Outer Ring Road network, strengthening connectivity across the eastern corridor of the Klang Valley. The alignment navigates challenging terrain and environmentally sensitive areas, incorporating elevated structures, complex interchanges, and modern electronic toll collection systems. Designed to

alleviate congestion on existing arterial routes, EKVE supports expanding urban development while enhancing traffic efficiency. The project reflects contemporary expressway engineering practices, integrating safety standards, traffic control systems, and sustainable design principles to meet the region's growing transportation demands.

### Award Criteria

- Contribution towards the economic and social wellbeing of the community served by the project in particular, and the nation in general
- Resourcefulness & innovation in planning, design, construction and solution of problems
- Safety features and operational safety record
- Reservation and protection of environment
- Pioneering use of materials and methods, particularly those of Malaysian origin
- Incorporation of futuristic and aesthetic values
- Promoting effectiveness for energy saving and carbon reduction AI-driven initiatives

### Panel of Judges

A panel of five judges, comprising prominent personalities in the road engineering industry, was invited to review and select the winning entry. The panel of judges have absolute discretion to accept or reject entries that do not comply with the requirements of the rules. The judges' discretion shall be final and binding on all entries, and no discussion or correspondence whatsoever relating to any of the judges' decision be entered into.

### Award

The Award consists of one challenge trophy for each category, three replicas and three certificates. The Project Owner, the Principal Designer and the Principal Contractor of the winning project shall each be awarded a replica and a certificate. The Project Owner shall be entitled to keep the challenge trophy for a period of six months, after which it shall be returned to REAM.
